Things to Consider

Top 10 ISP Ratings

- 1. Support** — There is no such thing as a perfect ISP.
- 2. Overselling** — What is your true bandwidth?
- 3. Redundancy** — Does your provider have more than one switching point?
- 4. Contact Hours** — Business isn't confined to the hours of 9-5.
- 5. Price** — Price is what you pay, value is what you get.
- 6. Terms** — Don't get stuck into a long-term commitment without future negotiations.
- 7. Freebies** — Don't get sold on freebies.
- 8. Value-Adds** — Some ISP's combine voice/data/etc.. Be careful—see number two.
- 9. Provisioning** — The length of time between purchase and service.
- 10. ISP Policies** — Content filtering, blocked ports, etc.
